Where we feel a pupil may benefit from using a focused object, the school will provide one as part of a planned approach to supporting that child's needs. This will always be discussed with parents to ensure it is appropriate and consistent. To help us manage this effectively, we kindly ask that parents do not provide or send fidget spinners or similar items into school. Thank you for your support in this matter.
